

The Saint Titus Athletic Club (STAC) Scholarship Information Statement

Thank you for your interest in The Saint Titus Athletic Club (STAC) Scholarship. This scholarship was founded in 2012 by the members of the Club to support the Catholic education of parishioners from Saint Titus Roman Catholic Church.

The STAC Scholarship will be offered to a parishioner student who will be entering Grades 7 through 12 at any Catholic school.

ELIGIBILITY

The STAC Scholarship is available to a Saint Titus Parishioner student based on the following criteria:

- Student must be eligible for a Parish tuition subsidy at a qualified school. The Pastor at St. Titus will be responsible for determining this eligibility.
- Submission of an essay titled “What does a Catholic education provide to you as an individual and how does that relate to your everyday life”.
- Involvement in athletic activities and scholastic extracurricular activities.
- Involvement in community service.
- Academic proficiency.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Eligible candidates may apply for the scholarship by completing the application form. The following materials must be completed and returned to the Saint Titus Parish Rectory in a sealed envelope with “STAC Scholarship” clearly marked on the front by **June 23, 2017**.

- A completed Application Form.
- Submission of essay. No minimum or maximum in terms of words and pages are required. All we ask is that the essay conveys an answer to the question.
- A copy of the prior year final report card and the most current report card.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection process will be conducted in a double blind format, meaning the identities of the candidate and the reviewer will be unknown to each other. After the submission deadline the Rectory will forward eligible applications to the STAC selection committee. Upon completion of the review process, a recipient will be selected. The recipient will be notified by the Rectory and a formal presentation of the award will be made at the weekend Masses soon after notification.

The STAC Scholarship is a partial-tuition scholarship (\$750) based on character, commitment, and promise. The scholarship is paid directly to the school. A student may submit an application for each year of eligibility. However, this is a "one-time" only Scholarship, meaning that you may not reapply if you are a prior awardee. Also, multiple members of the same household may be awarded the scholarship, but only one award per household member.
